## Making Connections & Installing LP Gas Equipment

The sale of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) equipment and service has been regulated since 1952. The governing statute is KRS 234.120, which has been amended over the years. The Hazardous Materials Section of the Division of Fire Prevention is responsible for reviewing and issuing LPG licenses.

**A class "E" LPG license is required if you are:** assembling, repairing, installing or connecting of LPG containers, regulating equipment, LPG appliances and any LPG utilization equipment in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The class "E" LPG license covers the company and all individuals that work for the company to do the LPG work. The license fee is \$50.00 for the first cycle period and renewal fee of \$50.00 annually thereafter. In accordance with KRS 234.120, you are required to maintain \$500,000 in general commercial liability insurance, which must be on file with our office.

To apply for an LPG license, you will need to complete the enclosed LPG license application for each location and send a check/money order in the amount of \$50.00 for each licensed location payable to the Kentucky State Treasurer and valid certificate of insurance to our office. The license will expire the last day of the birth month of the sole proprietorship or in the Kentucky incorporation/organization month.
